

The regular meeting of the New Plymouth Planning and Zoning Commission was called to order at 7:15pm at the New Plymouth City Hall on Monday, May 28, 2009. Roll call was held. Chairman Tegethoff was present as well as commission members Balcer, Williamson, Scheihing and Allen in attendance. Commissioner Byers was absent from the meeting. Staff member Leon K. Jensen, acting secretary of the commission was also present.

Roll call was not taken however; Chairman Tegethoff was present as well as commission members Allen, Scheihing, Williamson, Byers and Balcer in attendance. Commissioner Nay was absent from the meeting. Staff member Leon K. Jensen, secretary of the commission was also present.

Guests included Chester Millsap, Lincoln Koehn and Lynn Koehn.

Commissioner Williamson moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Byers with the voting unanimous in favor.

The minutes for the 23rd of March 2009 were presented for approval. **Commission Balcer moved to approve the minutes seconded by Commissioner Williamson with the voting unanimous in favor.**

The minutes for the 30th of April 2009 were presented for approval. **Commissioner Balcer moved to approve the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Byers with the voting unanimous in favor.**

No old business was discussed.

The commission was positive regarding the request of the Treasure Valley Mennonite Church for annexation. **Commissioner Byers moved to make a recommendation to the Council to approve the request for annexation. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williamson.** The voting was unanimous in favor.

Commissioner Byers moved to approve the request for a school on the subject property, seconded by Commissioner Scheihing with the voting being unanimous in favor. There were no conditions set.

Commissioner Byers asked if there were conditions to be set. Following some discussion **Commissioner Byers moved to approve the request for a church on the subject property, seconded by Commissioner Scheihing with the voting being unanimous in favor.** There were no conditions set.

Discussion was held regarding rescinding the part of the minutes for the 30th of April dealing with the proposed rezone and annexation for the Treasure Valley Mennonite Church. It was decided that no further action was necessary.

Commissioner Williamson moved to adjourn the regular meeting of the planning and zoning commission. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Balcer. The voting was unanimous in favor.
