**Councilman Warnke made a motion to approve the Preliminary Budget for FY2022. Councilwoman Kurth seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote. Councilman Hoppell, no. Councilman Warnke, yes. Councilwoman Kurth, yes. 2 yeses, 1 no. Motion carried.**
