On the 20th of September 2021, the New Plymouth City Council meeting was called to order at 5:59 P.M. by Mayor Rick York.

The pledge of allegiance was led by Councilwoman Cora Kurth.

Roll call was taken with council members Bill Warnke, Cora Kurth, Eileen Balcer and Tom Hoppell present.

Staff members in attendance were City Clerk Danielle Painter, Deputy Clerk Marianne Gatchell, and City Attorney Dan Chadwick.

Guests present were Mark Fulwiler, Ty Everson, David Everson, and Toni Blackletter.

Councilwoman Balcer moved to amend the agenda to include Resolution No. 2021-02 with action item b, Hardin Sanitation Rate Increase. Councilman Hoppell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

September 7th, 2021 City Council Minutes- Action Item

Councilman Warnke made a motion to approve the minutes from September 7, 2021. Councilwoman Balcer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Claim Approvals- Action Item

Councilman Hoppell made a motion to approve claim approvals totalling \$23,446.93. Councilwoman Balcer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

New Business – (Action Item)

- a. Ty Everson-Eagle Scout Project. Ty Everson presented his Eagle Scout project to the council. He is asking permission from the council to place a flag retirement box which will be located outside the VFW on N Plymouth Ave. The box will hold approximately 7 flags. Councilwoman Balcer said this was a fantastic idea and commended Ty for helping the community with this project.
Councilwoman Balcer made a motion to approve Ty Everson's Eagle project. Councilwoman Kurth seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- b. Hardin Sanitation Rate Increase-Mark Fulwiler from Hardin Sanitation presented the rate increase to the council. There was some miscommunication with the percentage of the rate increase. The rate increase will be over 5% so it requires a public hearing which will be set for October 18th, 2021.
- c. Application for Special Events Permit-Trunk or Treat.
Councilwoman Balcer made a motion to approve the application for Special Events Permit for Trunk or Treat. Councilman Hoppell seconded the motion. Motion carried.
