On the 17th of January 2017, the New Plymouth City Council meeting was called to order at 6:28 P.M. by Mayor Beth Earles. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilwoman Cora Kurth. Roll call was taken with council members Ron Rouse, Rick York, Bill Warnke and Cora Kurth in attendance.
